



The rules of the Tournament

Official FIBA Europe U15 category Tournament



Article 1

Saumur Loire Basket 49 club organizes two International Youth Tournaments called TIM 2024 which will take place

From Saturday 30th March to Sunday 31th 2024.

10 girl and 10 boy teams will participate in this tournament.
Each team is made up of **10 players** written down on each match sheet .

Article 2

Many Guest countries:

Germany, Belgium, Czech Republic, France

Article 3

The tournament is reserved for basketball players (boys and girls) who are members of a national Federation and were born in 2009 or 2010
(Children born in 2011 can be accepted as well).

Each participant will be required to produce a Club Membership Card with a photograph attached to it.

No special dispensation for this rule can be accepted. Any cheating as to the identity of a player will be punished by the exclusion of the whole team.

Article 4

Organization of the tournament (saturday)

- **The girl's tournament is organised along the same lines as the boy's tournament**
- **The 10 teams, which take part in the tournament, are split up into 2 groups of 5 teams.**
 - At first, each team will play once against all the other teams of the group.
 - The two first teams in each group will play in the semi finals, then a ranking match according to the result (1st to 4th place).
 - 3rd and 4th of each group will play small semi finals, then a ranking match according to the result (places from 5th to 8th)
 - The last teams in each group will play a ranking match for 9th to 10th places

Organization of the Tournament (final phases, sunday)

- Progress of the tournament semi finals (1st to 4th place)

1st Pool A vs 2nd Pool B (2*10min)

2nd in Pool A vs 1st in Pool B (2*10min)

- Small semi finals of the tournament (5th to 8th place)

3rd in Pool A vs 4th in Pool B (2*10min)

4th in Pool A vs 3rd in Pool B (2*10min)

- Tournament Standings Sequence

9/10 places : 5th in Pool A vs 5th in Pool B (2*10min)

7/8 places : losers in the small semifinal (2*10min)

5/6 places : winners of the small final (2*10min)

3/4 places : loser of the semi-final (2*10min)

places ½ : winner of the semi-final (2*12min)



Article 5

Material

The ball will be a: n° 6 for the Girls Tournament

n° 7 for the Boys Tournament

Rules

The FIBA rules will be applied except for:

1. Playing time

- 2 periods of 10 minutes each , deducted for group matches, for the small semi-finals of the 3rd and 4th of each group as well as for the ranking matches of the 5th to the 10th places, for the semi finals of the first two of each group and the ranking match 3rd and 4th.
- 2 periods of 12 minutes each, deducted for the final

2. Extensions

- In case of a tie at the end of the regular time period in the final phases of the tournament, the 2 teams will play as many extensions deducted as tie results. 1 period of 3 minutes.

3. Time out

- one time-out of one minute can be granted to each team during each playing period.
- For the games in 2*12 and 2*15, 2 time-outs can be granted in the second half,
- During extensions one time out will be granted to each team.

4. Fouls

- A player who has committed 4 fouls will be eliminated
- Free throw when there are 5 fouls in a team
- Free throw when there are 6 fouls in a team only for the final



5. out of bounds

- If an out of bounds is whistled in the back zone, the ball does not need to be touched by the referee. The touch must be made at the point of exit from the field.

6. substitution

- Substitution will be made through the scorer's table. no substitution will be granted if a throw-in takes place in the backcourt, unless the game is interrupted for:
 - A foul called,
 - A time-out granted,
 - A prolonged stoppage of play

7. Rests between each playing period

- The rests will be 3 minutes each

8. Defence system

- Any type of defense will be authorized

9. Classification

- The classification in each group will be established from the won points:
 - won match = 3 points
 - tie = 2 points
 - lost match = 1 point
 - Lost match by penalty or default = 0 points
- A team who will not be present at the set time to play their match will lose by default and score 0 points.

10. In case of equality

- **In case of equality of points between teams in the same group, the classification will be determinate from:**
 - 1 - particular goal average between these teams
 - 2 - best attack
 - 3 - best defense

Article 6

Warm up

Warm-up time granted to each team before the game will vary according to the end of the preceding match. It will be up to the technical staff in charge of the teams to deal with this warm-up period. Matches will have to start at the time stated on the planning of the matches.

Article 7

SLB 49 club will see to the refereeing, the score and the tinning of the all the matches.

Article 8

A regulation committee consisting of some organizers of SLB 49 club will be in charge of disputes concerning, either the application of the regulation, or any unexpected situation. The decision of this committee will be final.

Article 9

Trophies and cups awarded at each tournament constitute the property of the winning club. The two winners of the tournament will be invited to the following tournament, the next year.

Article 10

Sportswear

Each team must bring:

- A set of numbered T-shirts and shorts of the colour of the club.
- A second set of T-shirts of a different colour, but with the same numbering
- Balls for warm-up.
- Bottle for each player during games
- Some pennants, stickers to exchange with your opponents.

The team is expected to wear similar tracksuits or same clothes during the ceremony.

Article 11

Each delegation must have their own insurance.

The organizing club cannot be held responsible for any theft that might occur on the various site where the games will be played.

The club will not pay for hospital or chemist expenses.

Article 12

Organization of the tournament:

No team will be allowed to leave Saumur before the end of the closing ceremony.

- **Accommodation:**

Accommodation is organized by the organizing club for all foreign teams and teams which do not come from Maine et Loire with a maximum of 12 people for each delegation. Extra members accompanying them will be accommodated at their own expenses. Therefore, please get in touch with the people in charge of the organization.

Article 13

Photos / vidéos

Photos and videos may be taken during matches and more generally at all locations where the tournament takes place, and may be published on our website and our social networks, without any commercial purpose. Acceptance of the conditions of participation implies authorization of these publications for the entire delegation registered for the tournament.

Registration for the tournament constitutes acceptance of these regulations.
